§ 35-1. Definition.

REFUSE — Shall mean all putrescible and nonputrescible solid waste, including garbage, rubbish, bottles, cans, papers, ashes, incinerator residue, street cleanings, brush, dead animals, offal, and solid, commercial and industrial waste.

§ 35-2. Regulation of sanitary landfill areas.

The Board of Trustees shall have the power to regulate by resolution any sanitary landfill area now or hereafter established.

§ 35-3. Littering prohibited.

No refuse shall be thrown, placed, left, deposited or dumped within the Village of Walton or in any sanitary landfill area now or hereafter established by the village, except at such place or places designated by the Board of Trustees.

§ 35-4. Transporting refuse for hire.

No person, firm or corporation shall transport refuse for hire to any sanitary landfill area now or hereafter established by the village without having first obtained a license therefor as hereinafter provided.

§ 35-5. License term, fee and renewal.

A license to transport refuse for hire shall be issued by the Village Clerk upon payment of an annual fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.). The term of such license shall be one (1) year from date of issuance, and such license may be renewed annually at an annual renewal fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.).

§ 35-6. Penalties for offenses.

A penalty of not less than ten dollars (\$10.) nor more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.) is hereby imposed for any violation of this chapter.

§ 35-7. Repeal of prior ordinances.

All prior ordinances or parts of ordinances of this village, including, but not limited to, Chapter 35, §§ 35-1 to 35-6 inclusive, are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.
