**A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC NOTICES
RELATING TO ADOPTION OF LOCAL LAWS**

- § 36-1. Public hearing required; time and contents of notice.**

Be it enacted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Walton as follows:

- § 36-1. Public hearing required; time and contents of notice.**

No local law shall be adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Walton until a public hearing has been held thereon in its final form before such Board of Trustees not less than three (3) nor more than thirty (30) days after public notice has been given of the time and place of the holding of such public

hearing. Such notice shall be given by the Village Clerk by causing the same to be published once in the official newspaper of the village. Such notice shall contain the title of the proposed local law and a brief explanatory statement thereof.

§ 36-2. Posting of notice of hearing.

The Village Clerk shall cause to be printed or otherwise reproduced copies of such proposed local law, and shall, not later than the day such notice is published, post one (1) such copy, together with the notice of hearing, in a conspicuous place in his office, and shall also make copies of such proposed local law available at his office for inspection by and distribution to any interested person during business hours.

§ 36-3. Posting and publication after adoption.

The Village Clerk shall forthwith, upon adoption of a local law by the Board of Trustees, post a copy thereof in a conspicuous place in his office and shall, within ten (10) days after such adoption, cause the local law, or an abstract thereof describing the same in general terms, to be published in the official newspaper of the village.

§ 36-4. Filing of proof of publication and posting.

Proof of publication of the notice of public hearing required by § 36-1 hereof, and proof of posting and publication required by § 36-3 hereof, shall be filed in the office of the Village Clerk.

§ 36-5. Numbering.

Each local law shall be numbered consecutively, beginning with number one (1), for each calendar year. When a local law

is finally adopted, and certified copies thereof are required by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law to be filed in the offices of the Village Clerk, the State Comptroller and the Secretary of State, the Village Clerk shall accordingly assign to such local law its appropriate number.

§ 36-6. When effective.

This local law shall take effect immediately.
