§ 42-1. **Certificate and permit required; revocation.**

No slaughterhouse or place for the killing or dressing of animals shall be kept or used within the corporate limits of the village, except that, upon the certificate of the Board of Health that a slaughterhouse at the place therein designated will not be offensive or dangerous or detrimental to the public health or comfort, the Board of Trustees may, by a resolution duly entered in their Minute Book, authorize the use of such building as a slaughterhouse at the place designated in such certificate, but for one (1) year only. Such permission shall not be held as a justification or defense against any person authorized by law to maintain an action against such slaughterhouse as a nuisance or for damages for its use or continuance. Provided, however, that such permission may be revoked at any time by the Board of Trustees, and such revocation shall take effect forty-eight (48) hours after service upon the proper parties of a copy of the resolution revoking the same.

§ 42-2. **Violations and penalties.**

A penalty not exceeding twenty-five dollars (\$25.) nor less than five dollars (\$5.) is hereby imposed for any violation of any provision of the foregoing section, and an additional penalty of five dollars (\$5.) for every day such slaughterhouse shall be kept or used as such, after notice from the Board of Trustees of the village to remove the same.
